

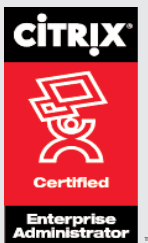

  - CTX-7130 - Citrix NFuse Classic Administration with Enterprise Services for NFuse
  - CTX-2300 - Citrix Securing Application Deployment over the Internet
  - CTX-1240 - Citrix MetaFrame XP for Windows Advanced Administration
- Take and pass four of the 10 qualifying exams

- You will receive a welcome kit with your certificate, CCEA number, and logo sheet.



The CCEA program is a technical certification that builds on the Citrix Certified Administrator (CCA) program. The CCEA program expands your knowledge of Citrix products and gives you even more extensive experience installing and administering the Citrix MetaFrame suite of products.

#### Application Information

- Please follow the steps below to complete the CCEA application process.
  - First log exam to CertManager ([www.certmanager.net/citrix](http://www.certmanager.net/citrix)) site after taking one or more qualifying Citrix Certification exams. Have a copy of your score report handy to make login easier. Please verify that your personal information is correct. Citrix will use this information to send your welcome kit upon completion of certification.
  - Next go to the Cert Progress section. From this section you can track your progress towards your CCEA certification.
  - Read and accept the Online Certification Agreement before you can complete the CCEA certification. You may accept the agreement only after you completed all four CCEA exams. If you do not accept the agreement, your certification will be listed as incomplete even though you have taken all the necessary exams.
  - Once you have updated or verified your information and accepted the agreement, you only need to pass the required exams to complete your certification. The Cert Progress section will provide a visual indicator of what exams you have taken, how they apply to your certification progress, and which exams you may still be take.
  - Once you pass all the exams, your certification will be complete. A certificate and welcome kit will automatically be mailed to you at the address listed in the personal information section. Please allow six weeks for welcome kit delivery.
